

# How to use this resource


This guide is here to help you explore different job opportunities, understand how your skills can be applied in creative jobs, and discover the pathways that can lead you to a fulfilling career.

**Musicians and Performers:** Make music or act to entertain audiences.




**Media Creators:** Produce films, videos, or online content that people watch and enjoy.
